

WASTEWATER CAPACITY RESERVATION NAME TRANSFER APPLICATION

The guidelines determining capacity, assessing impact fees, and issuing points of connections are located within <u>Chapter 47</u> of the City of Houston Code of Ordinances and the <u>Impact Fee Service Unit Equivalency Table</u>.

All name transfer applications must be accompanied with:

- 1. A recorded deed, title report, title option or title insurance policy for the property.
- 2. Copies of the Wastewater Capacity Reservation Letters.
- 3. Impact Fee or Capital Recovery Charge Receipts.

STATEMENT OF TRANSFER OF WASTEWATER CAPACITY

- 4. Site plan or survey of the land under consideration.
- 5. Processing fee
- 6. The form must be signed by property owners and notarized.

Please note: A new Wastewater Capacity Reservation Letter will not be issued; a name transfer receipt will be issued that represents the City's acknowledgment of the transfer of capacity. It may take one to two weeks to process a Wastewater Capacity Reservation Name Transfer application.
